Format

This event will be held online using RealBridge . Format 6 rounds of 12 boards , Swiss, first draw random Playing time: players have 75 minutes to complete the round

Internet communication

Team Captains

- are to check and ensure that all members of their team are familiar with playing RealBridge online and have successfully trialled their video and audio connections as per this link
- are required to have the contact phone numbers of their team members available on request in case of communication failure.
- in the event of communication issues

a. Before the start of a match, the captain is required to phone the player and try to sort it out.

b. During the match notify the director /assistant director who will try to engage further help to try to restore the player to the game

• Should a player's communication prevent a board from being played, for the first board this will be scored as "not played ", for the second and subsequent boards, the director/ scorer will apply NZ Bridge Tournament Regulations paragraph 7(punctuality and slow play)

Allowable Systems There are no restrictions, however, teams using Hums should notify the director before the start of the event and the director will inform them of their rights and obligations.

Alerting.

- Pre alerts. At the start of the match players should prealert their opponents using the chat box
- · During the round, players should announce and alert as if it were face to face bridge.

<u>Undos</u>

The player requesting an undo should call the director ; if this player omits to do so, any of the other three players should do so .
