IMPROVER LESSONS

<u>Who For:</u> Players who feel they have the basics of Bridge under their belts, are playing regularly and want to start developing systems or conventions, they can use to help the bidding and playing process. These lessons will aid the understanding of what each of you are telling your partner about your hand or how to ask a question about your partner's hand and how to respond.

By whom: Hilary and Kathryn will be running a new series of Improver Lessons at the club. No table money is required.

<u>When:</u> Starting Monday 17 March for 4 nights - 17, 24, 31 March and 7 April. 7pm start for a 40/50-minute instruction/discussion and then play a few hands to practise what you have learnt. Each session will be 1.5/2 hours long.

LEARNING ONLINE

Several free learning opportunities are available to improve bridge skills. Graeme Tuffnell from New Zealand hosts live-streaming sessions every Monday at 8 p.m. He reviews the first 10 hands from Sky Bridge's daily game, which runs from 6 p.m. Monday to 5:59 p.m. Tuesday. If you can't catch the live stream, past sessions are available on graemetuffnell.com

Before tuning into Graeme's stream, players can participate in a free daily deal on SkyBridge, which he reviews. A subscription costs approximately NZ\$18 monthly and provides unlimited access to Sky Bridge games https://skybridgeclub.com/

Additionally, players can enhance their skills through Intobridge. They can play five boards daily for free, selecting the Acol bidding system during setup. After completing these boards, users can watch a video explaining the thought processes of international players. For further practice, players can also compete in five daily games against others with similar ratings. Unlimited access to Intobridge is available for around £11 per month.

BRIDGE BOARDS

Hello from Christine and Marian. We deal the boards for each session. To make dealing easier it would be great if all the boards are returned to the box at the end of each session. Please note:

- The boards need to be in numerical order and facing the same direction. Each box has "please place boards this way no. 1 first".
- We place a copy of the Hand Analysis in each box for you to take at the end of the session. Any spares are placed in the holders in the foyer.
 Please advise the director if we are not making enough copies of these so that we can increase the number.
- If you come across a broken or chipped card, please place a bidding sheet with the card number in the slot under the board, thus ensuring that the next table playing this board can't see this information.

Thank you for your help with this. It makes a huge difference when preparing the boards.
