

BRIDGE TIPS:

The following tips have been provided by a qualified Director in Canterbury and will be provided in instalments in subsequent newsletters.

Introduction:

The Laws contain many legal restrictions on what players can and cannot do.

"Each player counts his cards face down to be sure he has exactly thirteen;"

"No player shall touch any cards other than his own"

"After the final pass either defender has the right to ask if it is his opening lead"

"... the defender on presumed declarer's left makes the opening lead face down"

"Dummy may not leave his seat to watch declarer's play of the hand."

"Until his side has led to the next trick, declarer or either defender may inspect, but not expose, his own last card played."

These are all pretty clear-cut as long as you know them.

Beyond this there are Laws about Unauthorised Information, Review and Explanation of Calls, Partnership Understandings which set out complicated rules for the players' behaviour. I will look at these in more detail over the coming weeks.

And finally there is **Law 74 - Conduct and Etiquette** which gives formal examples of do's and don'ts. There are three sections !

A. Proper Attitude

1. A player should maintain a courteous attitude at all times.

2. A player should carefully avoid any remark or extraneous action that might cause annoyance or embarrassment to another player or might interfere with the enjoyment of the game.

3. Every player should follow uniform and correct procedure in calling and playing.
